

Camping Information

- Early or Late Arrivals: By prior Arrangement
- Strictly No camping below signs at Tranquillity (flat around BBQ & Campfire area)
- There are no BBQ's available at the camping ground. All camp fires need to be in enclosed areas (use rocks available) Preferably use a fuel stove for cooking, wood can be gathered from around the property by picking up fallen timber or you can purchase cut wood from the office for \$10/bag.
- Showers and toilets are located in the village **please see map*. We request that you keep these facilities as tidy as possible. If there is any problems please report it to reception straight away, and we will endeavour to rectify any problems. These facilities will be closed for cleaning between 10am-12md on busy days.
- We ask that you abide by the speed limit at all times **20kms** per hour when driving around the property, this essential requirement is both for your safety and other guests on the property and our livestock.
- The picnic area at Tranquillity is for the use of ALL OUR GUESTS. We ask, if you use this area that you use the rubbish bins provided. The BBQ can be used for a nominal fee of \$5.00 for 2 hours – Gas bottle is to be returned to reception and BBQ is to be left clean.
- The resort is a sanctuary for all flora and fauna. **No one** is permitted to bring firearms onto the property or to disturb the natural environment. Care and common sense should be taken when approaching animals.
- Campfire at Tranquillity - you are welcome to use it. Please feel free to collect firewood from around the property, please use only fallen trees, you are **NOT** permitted to cut anything down.
- **Property - Damage & Loss.**
All breakages or break down of Bestbrook equipment is to be reported to Bestbrook Mountain Resort Management. Bestbrook Mountain Resort takes **NO** responsibility for the loss or damage to personal property.
- **Firewood** - Please do not take split firewood from the cottages as this is for Inside the Cabins (potbellied stoves) **ONLY**
- **Rubbish** – We will be conducting a rubbish run every morning; we ask that all rubbish be secured in garbage bags for easy disposal.
- **Water** – Is available at the Coach House. Please bring your container to reception for refilling of fresh drinking water.
- **Shop** - Ice and some food items (bread, milk & soft drinks are available for sale at reception.)
- **Trail Bike** riders –please report to reception. A Motor Sport Indemnity must be filled out.
- **Please note:** A sewerage system does not operate at Bestbrook all amenities are septic systems. Chemical toilet waste, feminine hygiene products must not be flushed. A dumping pit has been installed for the disposal of Chemical toilet material - asks for direction at reception.

Rules and Regulations

Motorcycles/Quads/other vehicles

- Safety helmets and all safety equipment shall be worn at all times, when operating a motorcycle.
- Motorcycles will not be started or ridden between 4.00pm – 8.00am.
- Motorcycles are not to be ridden unnecessarily around the camping areas or raced up and down the golf course. Anyone found doing so will be told to leave.
- Children riding motorcycles must only ride on the tracks and must be under adult supervision at all times.
- Access to the 100 acres on the other side of the road is from the front gate of Bestbrook.
- Tracks have been provided for your enjoyment & safety it is at your own risk that you deviate from these tracks.
- Remember to make sure that everyone riding bikes are travelling in the same direction.
- **Horses have total right of way** -When approaching a trail ride all vehicles must stop and turn off motor.
- All gates must be left as signs indicate or as you have found them.
- All tracks are TWO way (other then organised events) – please observe road rules.
- **In wet weather all tracks become treacherous it is strongly recommended that you do not use any of the mountain tracks after rain – DO NOT PASS – anyone ignoring this warning and getting stuck on the mountain will incur a charge for recovery of there vehicle.**

Camping Areas

- Generator noise is to be kept to a minimum at night and during the early morning (not before 7am and no later then 10.00pm).
- Vehicle movement is to be kept to a minimum around the camping areas.
- Noise is to be kept to a minimum between 10.00pm and 7.00am
- When arriving at camping areas after 7.00pm – setting up camp should be conducted without disturbing other campers. Low beam head lights are to be used in camping area at night.
- All fires are to be fully extinguished when finished with.
- All rubbish to be placed in garbage bags and placed in bins provided. At peak times a rubbish run will be conducted daily to pick up rubbish from your camps site sometime during the morning.
- Bottles & cans are not to be put in the fire (livestock roaming around the property can sustain injuries because of litter bugs).

General Conduct

- Children must be supervised at all times
 - No firearms, archery equipment or the likes are to be brought on to the property.
 - No motor vehicles are to be operated by person under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
 - Water is precious please use it sparingly.
 - Dogs are not allowed at the coach house or around the animal yards unrestrained. Bestbrook has 2 resident dogs – **Socks & Mate** - they are very people friendly and oversee all goings on around the property. If in the event you feel they are too friendly kindly advise the office and we will tie them up.
 - There is a **Speed limit of 20kms** all over the property.
- Breach of rules will result in a warning or removal from the property. In the event of eviction from property – guests will forfeit any monies paid and remain liable for any fees owing at the time of removal.
