

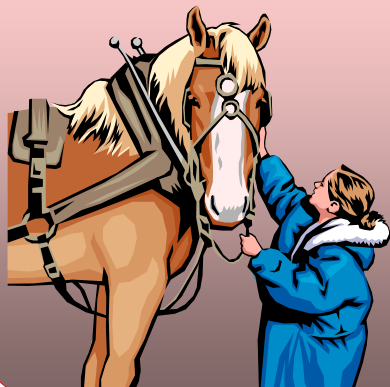

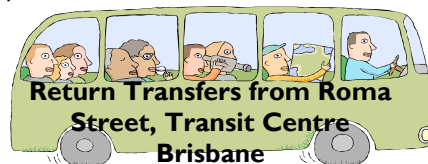

## 5 DAY CAMPS

Thank you for your interest in our School Holiday Horse Riding Camps. Bestbrook Mountain Resort was established in late 1980s, it consists of 500 beautiful acres and is situated 38km east of Warwick and 120km west of Brisbane. Visitors can enjoy the peaceful farm surroundings with peacocks, sheep, poultry, cows and horses.

Our 5 Day Riding Camps are held during every school holidays, from 12pm Monday to the 1pm Friday. Bestbrook Mountain Resort Horse Riding Camp is fully catered, has full insurance, qualified Instructors and adult supervision.

Ages of children attending camp are 8-15yrs. Learner riders are welcome.

### **COST**

The price for our 5 Day Camp is \$420.00 per child or 4 day April Camp is \$320

Includes accommodation, meals, activities.

Please go to [www.bestbrook.com.au](http://www.bestbrook.com.au) and book in online and pay your \$50 deposit now to hold your spot. Please book early to avoid disappointment and be aware that deposits cannot be refunded except under exceptional circumstances. Balance owing must be paid prior to camp.

### **TRANSPORT**

We hire a bus and pick up from Brisbane Transit centre, McDonalds at Goodna and McDonalds at Yamanto alternatively you can make your own way hear.

The bus departs at the time specified on the timetable, it cannot wait therefore it is vitally important that parents are at least 10 minutes early for pick up and drop off.

Private transport campers are to arrive no earlier than 11:00am and can be collected at 1.00pm on the Friday.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

Our dorms are located a short walk from the main coach house. There are separate boys and girls dorms with their own hot showers and toilets. All cabins have double bunks and mattresses. A supervisor sleeps with the children and assists in each cabin.

Children are required to care for their belongings and keep their cabins tidy. Let us know on your booking form if your child would like to share a cabin with a friend that is also attending camp.

### **SUPERVISION**

All our supervisors hold their blue cards. Supervisors sleep in the cabins with the children so there is 24 hour supervision. Owners live on site and are fully involved in running and supervising the camp.

### **PHONE CALLS**

To minimize disruption to the camp routine, please keep calls to a minimum or emergencies. If it is necessary to call your child please call after 6.30pm as this is when the children are having dinner. Children are not encouraged to use the phone. We will ring if there is a serious problem.

### **DINING**

We have a large dining area where all campers meet for meals. Please let us know if your child has any special dietary needs as we will happily cater for them. This mean vegetarian or gluten free.

### **CAMP RULES**

Our first priority is safety, closely followed by as much fun as possible. To ensure a happy and enjoyable camp for all we have established a set of rules to which we expect our campers to adhere. These will be explained to campers on day of arrival.

Campers are reminded that cigarettes, alcohol or other drugs are not permitted at our camp and any breakages must be paid for.

### **BEHAVIOUR**

Children with behavioral problems are a risk to other campers and parents are required to ensure that their children understand and are able to respect the rights of others with regard to safety of persons and property, manners and privacy.

**SNACK BAR** The Snack Bar is open in the morning and afternoon and sells drinks, chips, ice blocks and sweets. All Wallets can be locked away in the office for safe keeping.

### **MOBILE PHONES**

We realize that mobile phones are a very easy way for you and your child to keep in touch. In the past we have had situations were children will ring their parents to fix a problem rather than informing one of our staff and this puts us in a very difficult situation as we can not fix a problem if we don't know about it. So while your child is on camp we need to be there first point of call if a problem should a rise. If a problem can not be solved by us then rest assured you will be our first call.
